TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The St Margaret's College Old Girls' Association offers to the descendants of Old Girls:

One 2 year Senior School Fee Assistance (FA) Scholarship. This is open to girls in Years 12 and 13 and can be held for a maximum of two years reviewed annually. It covers half the yearly tuition fees.

FEE ASSISTANCE (FA)

DESCRIPTION:

- The FA is advertised with the other St Margaret's scholarships and is available for new or existing students entering Year 12 & 13 in 2016
- Applications close on 31 August 2015.
- FA is awarded end of October.
- FA commences Term 1 of the following year.
- Applicants are required to fill in the Fee Assistance Application Form annually.
- Recipients will require written proof from official sources of ongoing financial need each year for the continuation of their FA.
- The current School Principal of the applicant may be contacted.
- SMCOGA reserves the right to make the final decision.
- FA will be deducted from school fee invoice.
- All financial information will be confidential.

CRITERIA:

1. Descendant of an Old Girl i.e. daughter, granddaughter, great granddaughter or niece (the Old Girl must be a financial member of the St Margaret's College Old Girls' Association)
2. Financial hardship
3. Year 12 or 13 student in 2016
4. Contribution to their present school
5. Attitude
