

## **Academic Scholarship Information for Year 9, 2018**

**Application Closing Date: Wednesday 10 May 2017 at 4.00pm**

**Examination Date: Monday 29 May 2017 from 9.00am-12.00noon**

**Value: 50% remission of tuition fees for five years**

A scholarship application form registers a student for the scholarship examinations only, not the waiting list for entry into the school. An application for enrolment pack for entry in 2018 can be obtained from the Enrolments Office on (03) 353 2563.

Applicants must submit a brief curriculum vitae in A4 format indicating sporting, cultural, leadership and community interests; a copy of her most recent school report and 2017 standardised test results; a photograph and a handwritten letter to the Executive Principal, Mrs Simpson, introducing herself and explaining why she wishes to attend St Margaret's College, along with her scholarship application form.

Details of the format for the morning will be sent to you by email in the week prior to the examination.

An interview with the Executive Principal for short-listed students and their parent/s will be required after the examination and prior to a scholarship being offered.

Successful candidates will be offered a scholarship on **Wednesday 14 June**.  
The acceptance of the place must be confirmed by **4.00pm** on **Monday 19 June**.

Notes:

- There is no charge for sitting the Scholarship examinations.
- Previous papers are not available and details of results are not supplied.
- Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
- Do not send original copies of any documents or certificates, as we do not return applications.
- Sister remissions will not apply to successful candidates.
- If your daughter's application is not successful, you will receive notification by email.
- Applications must be hard copies – no emails.
- Applicants must be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents of New Zealand.
- **You may apply for more than one scholarship, however only one scholarship will be awarded per student.**
- **Each application must be accompanied by a full set of supporting documents.**
