TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The St Margaret's College Old Girls' Association offers descendants of Old Girls one Senior School Fee Assistance Scholarship. This is open to girls in Year 12-13 and can be held for a maximum of two years, reviewed annually.

The Fees Assistance Scholarship covers up to 50% of the annual tuition fees.

Description:

- The Fees Assistance Scholarship is advertised with other St Margaret's College scholarships and is available for new or existing Year 12 and 13 students.
- All financial information provided by the applicant will be treated in the strictest confidence.
- Applications close at 4pm on Friday 23 August 2024.
- The Fees Assistance Scholarship is awarded at the end of October / early November.
- The Fees Assistance Scholarship commences Term 1 the following year.
- If applying for a scholarship for a Year 12 student, applicants are required to complete the Fee Assistance Application Form annually. Recipients will be required to provide written proof from official sources of ongoing financial need each year for the continuation of their Fees Assistance Scholarship.
- The Fees Assistance Scholarship will be deducted from the school fee invoice.
- The recipient may remain confidential at the request of the family.

Criteria:

- Direct descendant of a St Margaret's College Old Girl daughter, granddaughter, greatgranddaughter
- Financial hardship
- Open to new or existing Year 12-13 students
- Evidence of contribution to their current school
- Exhibiting a positive attitude
