



2025 Fees and Concession Rates

Enrolment Fee

All applications for enrolment must be accompanied by a non-refundable fee of \$200.

Acceptance Fee

An acceptance fee of \$1,600 is required once a place is offered. This fee provides your daughter with the benefits of a lifetime membership of the St Margaret's College Old Girls' Association. If the student does not take up the place, no refund is payable.

Tuition (per year)

Years 1 – 3 \$18,210.00 incl GST

Years 4 – 6 \$23,200.00 incl GST

Years 7 – 8 \$27,050.00 incl GST

Years 9 – 13 \$30,420.00 incl GST

International Baccalaureate Diploma Levy (Years 12 & 13) \$1,500.00 per year incl GST

Boarding

\$18,795.00 per annum incl GST per year.

There is no concession for weekday boarders. A term's notice advising of a change of status, i.e. Boarder to Daygirl must be given, otherwise the equivalent term's boarding fee will be charged.

Building Fund Contribution

An annual fee is charged. Funds are used for the continued development of the College's facilities and resources.

Parents' and Friends' Association

An annual subscription to the Association is charged on their behalf.

Payment of Fees

Tuition and boarding fees are charged in ten equal monthly instalments (January to October) and become payable on the 20th month following. It is mandatory for all students to pay by direct debit.

Sister Concessions

For families with two or more daughters attending the College concurrently, the College offers a 5% discount on tuition fees and a 5% discount on boarding fees for the second daughter and 10% for the third and subsequent daughters.

Pre-Payment Discount

The College offers a 2% discount on tuition and boarding fees on pre-payment of the student's total annual fees by 20 February each year. Please contact the Finance Office for assistance in organising the discounted payment.

International Students

ESOL

An additional fee will be charged for students who are not International students, but require ESOL tutoring.

Please Note:

1. One term's written notice of intention to withdraw the student from the College is required and all fees incurred over the notice period must be paid. Where no notice is given, a fee of one term's tuition and boarding fees will be charged in lieu of notice.
2. Boarding fees are payable for the full year and will only be prorated for early withdrawals prior to the 1st September, irrespective of notice, unless for reasons of family home relocation to within the greater Christchurch area or withdrawal from the School after this date.
3. The Trust Board of the College meets each year to discuss any increases in the school fees for the following year. Information about fees for 2026 will be available from the Finance Office.
