

Accounting Teacher and Curriculum Leader Full time, Fixed Term 14/07/25 – 17/07/26 (Parental leave cover)

The Role

We are currently seeking an inspiring and enthusiastic Accounting Teacher and Curriculum Leader to teach from Year 9 to 13. The teacher needs to meet and extend the needs of their learners through sounds NZ curriculum teaching, strong pedagogical practice including digital technology, blended learning, and differentiation. Demonstrated experience of teaching Accounting is required. Knowledge or experience of Business studies and/or Social studies is an advantage. This position is to cover a period of parental leave.

The position is based on site at St Margaret's College, 12 Winchester Street, Merivale, Christchurch, travel will not be required. This is a full-time position, 40 hours per week Monday to Friday.

Applicants must be able to start from 14 July 2025 (optional earlier start date if available) and work through to 17 July 2026, fixed term, to cover for a period of parental leave.

The terms and conditions, including base salary, for this position is set by the St Margaret's Collective Agreement. The base salary for trained teachers will range from \$75,340 to \$103,086 per annum (Step 5-10), depending on applicant's qualifications and experience. Additional to the base salary is a 0.5 Accounting management unit (\$2,500 per annum), prorated between the start date and end of 2025. SMC also provides an SMC allowance of \$4,300 per annum, pro-rated to end of 2025 and \$4,500 per annum, pro-rated, from January 2026. Individuals' actual base salary will be established by a salary assessment once a role is confirmed.

Applicants must have knowledge of the New Zealand Curriculum. They must commit to the vision and values of the College and demonstrate a commitment to be part of a well-resourced and supportive environment with motivated students who are keen to learn.
